ORDINANCE No. 887

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ASTON, DELAWARE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 1860.06 OF THE ASTON TOWNSHIP
CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT DISCARDING GRASS CLIPPINGS IN THE
STREET AND PUBLIC AREAS**

WHEREAS, the Aston Township Board of Commissioners previously adopted an ordinance which prohibits littering of rubbish and waste materials; and

WHEREAS, the Aston Township Board of Commissioners now seek to specifically include grass clippings as waste material which shall not be discarded in public streets and highways; and;

WHEREAS, the Aston Township Board of Commissioners believe that prohibiting grass clippings from being blown into the streets and public highways is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of its citizens as it will prevent the storm sewers from being clogged and otherwise adversely affecting the storm water flow in its neighborhoods.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved and Adopted this 17th day of November 2010, by the Aston Township Board of Commissioners that Chapter 1860.06 shall read as follows:

1860.06 LITTERING


No person shall throw or place or be a party to any throwing or placing of any papers, bottle, cans grass clippings or other rubbish or waste materials on any lawn, vacant lot, public area, sidewalk, street or public highway in the Township.

Effective date - this Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days from the date of adoption.


Repealer - any prior ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Severability - the provisions of this ordinance and code sections adopted hereby are severable, and if any clause, sentence or section thereof shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such decision or judgment shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
