[Peddlers Permit Information](#)

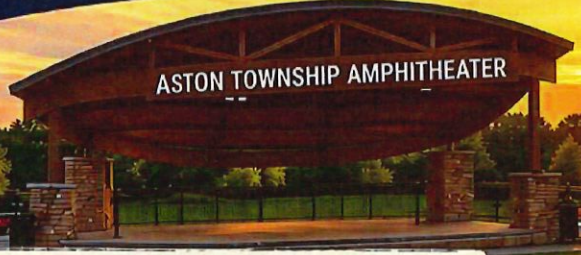
